

# Travel safely this Thanksgiving

## In the car:

- Everyone in the vehicle should be buckled up - either in a seat belt, booster seat or car seat.
- Kids under 13 should never ride in the front seat.
- All loose objects are secured in the car. A loose umbrella or snow scraper could cause injury if the vehicle stops suddenly or crashes.

## In the air:

- Kids under 40 pounds should ride in a car seat on an airplane.
- The car seat should be in the window seat so it doesn't block other passengers.
- Make sure that your car seat can be used on the plane, look for a label that says, "This Restraint is Certified for Use in Motor Vehicles and Aircraft".
- Be sure your child is not seated in an emergency exit row.
- Make sure that when you reach your destination your vehicle has enough safe seating positions and appropriate child safety seats for your family.
